

2000 Public Hearing and Workshop Summary Sheet

Table 1 - Segment C 2000 Public Hearing and Workshop Commenter Index and Table 2 - Segment C 2000 Public Hearing and Workshop Comments and Responses are provided to identify individuals (commenters) that submitted comments regarding the Public Hearing held on June 13, 2000 and Public Workshop held on November 14, 2000. The commenters and their respective comments, as well as the response to the comments provided by the Grand Parkway Association (GPA), are provided in Tables 1 and 2.

Table 1 is arranged alphabetically by last name and represents the list of commenters along with letter-number references for each comment made by that commenter. The letter-number reference ("Comments Made" column) refers to the "Comment Category" column in Table 2. This is to aid the commenter in determining the GPA responses to their comment. To determine comments and responses, the commenter must first locate their name in Table 1. Upon finding their name they must review the last column "Comments Made" and determine the specific comment category letter-number reference listed in Table 2. Once the commenter has identified their comment category letter-number reference they can then proceed to Table 2 to read the comment and response. The "Commenter Number" was assigned to each comment as they were received by the GPA and is used for organizing comments.

Table 2 provides a list of public meeting comments received along with responses from the GPA in coordination with TxDOT and FHWA. As previously mentioned the "Comment Category" in Table 2 refers to the "Comments Made" column in Table 1 and should be used as a cross-reference tool to identify the comments received for each commenter.

Copies of the original comments are included at the end of Volume II. To find a commenter's original comment (in the form of a transcript for verbal comments, a print-out for emails, or a photocopy of letters), cross-reference the commenter's name (listed alphabetically in Table 1 below) with his or her assigned "Commenter Number." This "Commenter Number" is placed within a box at the beginning of the comment copy located at the end of Volume II. For organizing responses (Table 2), comments were categorized into one of eight categories, as follows:

- A. Need and Purpose of the Project
- B. Alternatives
- C. Socioeconomic Issues
- D. Natural and Physical Environmental Issues
- E. Indirect and Cumulative Impacts
- F. Environmental Documentation
- G. General Comments
- H. Right-of-Way
